

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Marengo Township, Calhoun County, Michigan, has received and accepted a petition and letter requesting its approval of annexation of certain lands in the Township hereinafter described, to the City of Marshall, pursuant to the alternate method of annexation provided for in Section 9 of Act 279 of the Public Acts of Michigan, 1909, as amended, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Act, said petition has been signed by all qualified electors residing in the territory proposed to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, such petition has been signed by holders of the record legal title to more than one-half (1/2) of the area of the land in the territory proposed to be annexed,

WHEREAS, such petition has been signed by more than thirty-five (35%) per cent of the total number of names which appear on the assessment roles of said Township as being assessed for real property taxes within the area proposed to be annexed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the Marengo Township Board does hereby give its approval to the annexation to the City of Marshall of the lands described as:

Commencing at a point where the North line of Territorial Road (East Michigan Avenue) intersects the Town Line between Section 25 in the Township (now City of Marshall) and Section 30 of the Township of Marengo; thence North along said Town Line 264 feet; thence North 73° 20' East, 172.26 feet; thence South parallel with said Town Line 264 feet to the North right-of-wayline of Territorial Road (East Michigan Avenue); thence South 73° 20' West along the North line of said Territorial Road (East Michigan Avenue) to the place of beginning, being a part of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 30, Town 2 South, Range 5 West, Marengo Township, Calhoun County, Michigan, and containing 1.04 acres of land more or less.
